TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TRAVEL

General

All rates are in Australian dollars, include GST and are valid until 31st March 2023. If applicable, \$7.00 per person Environmental Management Charge (EMC) is inclusive in all marine cruise rates from 1st July 2022. The EMC is vitally important to the management of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park and World Heritage Area. All trips and activities, prices and schedules are subject to change. Some services may be cancelled or modified as a result of weather/tidal conditions or other unforeseen circumstances. Cancellation fees may apply. Christmas Day surcharge applies.

Diving All diving is subject to completion of an onboard medical questionnaire. This is available to view on our website prior to travel: www.reefmagic.com.au. Certain medical conditions, (ie: asthma, epilepsy, high blood pressure) or medications may exclude individuals from

diving. Please check when booking. The minimum age to SCUBA dive is 12 years with parent/guardian permission required. Certified Divers must produce their certification card. After diving, intervals of 12-24 hours are recommended prior to flying depending on depths of dives and accrued dive time.

Helicopters

All helicopter rates are per person. Child age is 3-14 years for all helicopter options. Minimum passengers required per flight. Flights and routes flown and aircraft type used are subject to weather, air traffic control, aircraft availability, passenger loads and ultimately the pilots discretion. Maximum of one infant permitted per flight. Maximum combined passenger weight limits apply per flight. Cancellation fees apply to no-shows and passengers cancelled with less than 24 hours prior notice.
